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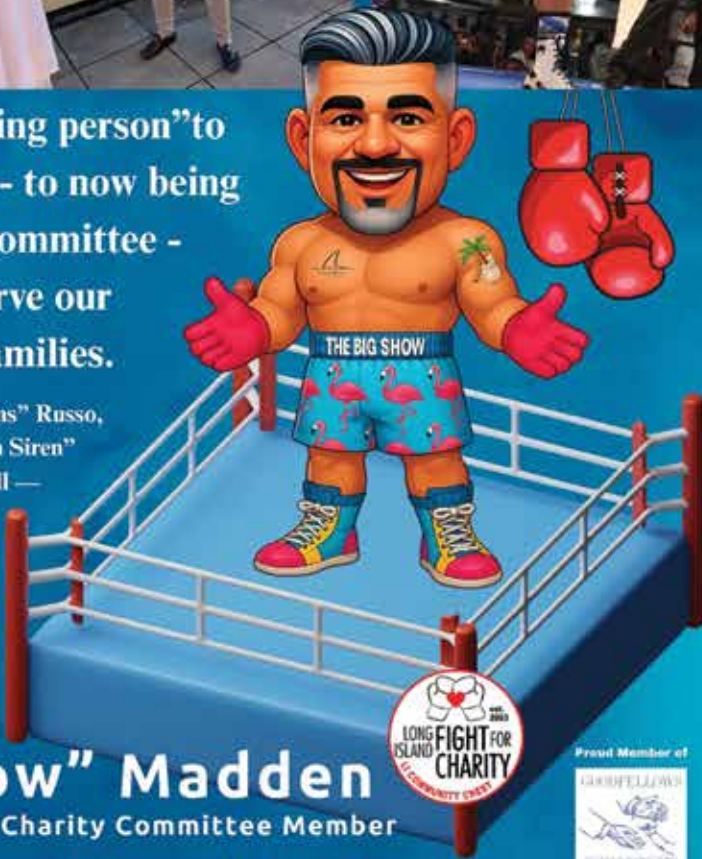

"Training for this event is giving me something to focus on that's greater than myself. Each time I get tired or don't want to keep working, I remind myself that I'm fighting for those who can't fight for themselves. I am learning



how to fight so others don't have to—so a family can get the help they need, so a child can have the supplies to succeed in school, so people facing hardship know they are not alone. While I may be the one stepping into the ring, the real victory comes from knowing we're making a difference together. Giving back always feels good, but this time, it feels more powerful than ever."

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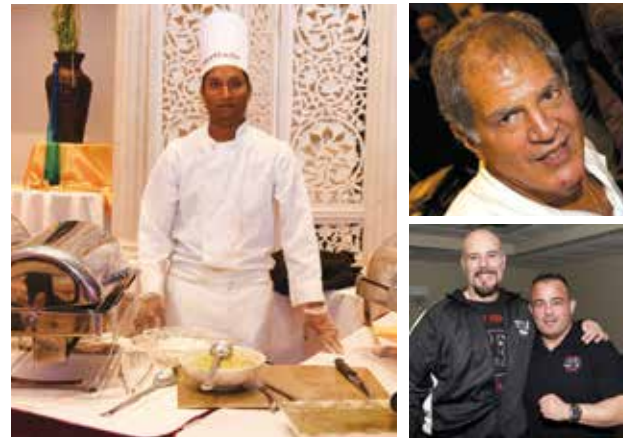


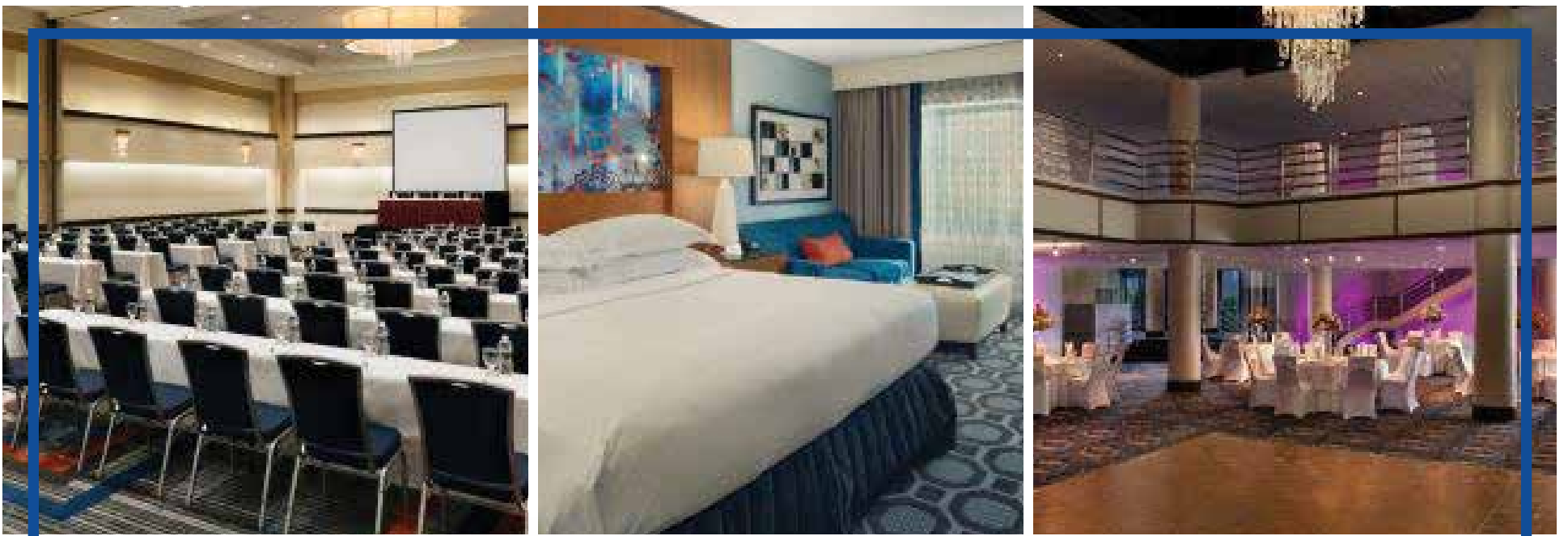

Bart "Hands of Steel" Schiavo



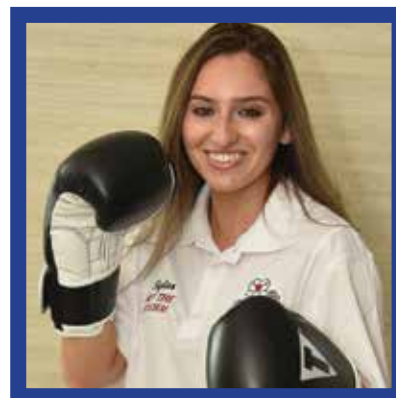
Bart Schiavo is the Owner & President of Schiavo Steel Co., Inc., a structural steel fabrication company.

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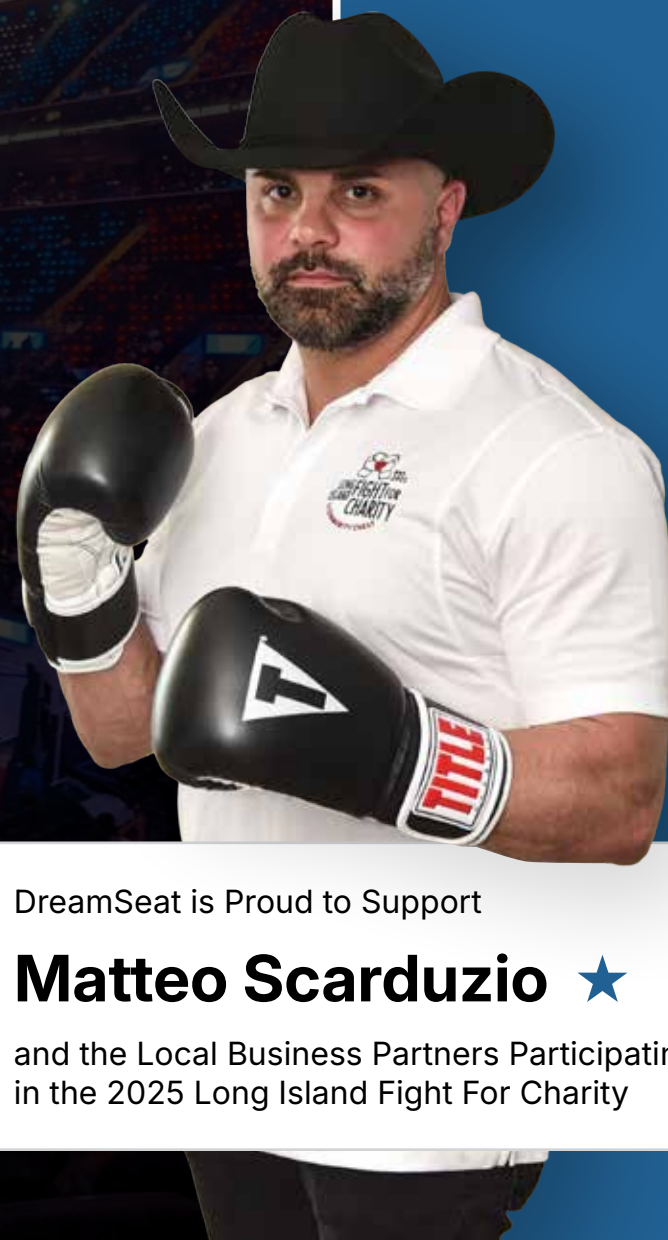
