

For Katy, this fight is about more than just stepping into the ring—it's about stepping up for others.



Genaro fights out of Huntington and enjoys spending time with his wife Jessie, and two daughters, Jada and Mila.


Robert "The Strategic Sledgehammer" DePalo Jr.
